



A NEW book '**Benthic Amphipoda (Crustacea: Peracarida) of the Great Barrier Reef**' co-edited by Dr Jim Lowry (Australian Museum) and Professor Alan Myers (National University of Ireland) is due for release by the online journal *Zootaxa* in late September or early October, 2009.

More than 90% of the species in this book have not previously been recorded from Australia. The amphipod fauna of the Great Barrier Reef is the richest fauna yet known from any tropical reef system. All species are **fully illustrated** and **interactive keys** to all species are provided with the book. Twenty international amphipod specialists document 49 families, 121 genera, and 235 species (about half of which are new to science).
